1. **Call meeting to order – 7:00pm**

NOTE: Players must play in at least 42 games to be eligible for any individual awards. Players must have played in at least 21 regular season games in order to be eligible to play in the tournament.

Rule Amendment review & discussion:

1. Shoot-out – Do you add hits, ECT. During a shoot-out to a players seasonal statistics/averages. Captains agreed that indeed this was being done. Unanimous vote approved.
2. Umpires –
 - a. Current rule 5.37/ Darts popping out of boards should not be counted as hit if it pops out before next batter has continued play.
 - b. Also if umpires are not in agreement of play of a dart it is counted as a “dead dart.”
 - c. Once an umpire decision is mad and the next batter has thrown a dart the umpire decision cannot be reversed on previous play/batter.
3. Current rule as of 2006 Rule book; Late arrivals- Late arrivals can only enter a game after game play starts as a substitute for active playing batter. Exception to this rule would be if the team is currently playing with an auto-out situation; “Otto”.

Old rule: Late arrivals could not enter play of a game after the 3rd inning.

Board conditions Review and discussion:

Suggestion that boards that dry-out should be soaked in water to recondition them.

Darts – Captains, please make sure darts are sharp and in good condition.

Current 2006 Rule book will be reviewed at the annual meeting/banquet. Anyone who doesn't have a copy of the current rule book should contact Becky.

- **REGULAR SEASON PLAY AWARD SHEETS:**
Captains PLEASE make sure you have the awards information sheet ready before we start the first night of play so the rules committee can determine who will receive trophies and trophies can be ordered as soon as possible. (Have the report sheets ready even though you don't think any of your team members won an award or trophy.) Also please have your team/player average sheet ready.
- **Banquet Reservations** must be in on the first night of the tournament with payment.

RULES of Tournament:

- Games will begin promptly at 7:30 P.M. each night.
- Players may throw a few warm-up darts before 7:25. There is to be **no practice** between games or after 7:25 P.M.
- Format: Round-robin & tie breakers to be determined by shoot-off
- The 7 player minimum rule will be in effect with an automatic out for any less than 7 players. All players must have played in at least 21 games during the regular season to be eligible to play in the tournament. Teams may play with more than 7 players if they wish.

Tournament Awards:

Only team placement/ rank of wins. 1st place, 2nd place, etc.
